The Reason Why

- My website Members Only Area(MOA) has had a number of hackers try to get in. I have been able to stop them but now is the time to up my game and put more security on my site. I am going to use 2 Factor Authentication 2FA. This will keep the hackers away for a long time. I realize it puts another step into the already hard process, but I feel it is necessary as I don't have the time or ability to track them each and every day.
- This action will insure those who login to my Members Only Area are who they say they are and you will be allowed to do or get what you want.


Discussion

- My 2FA has been improved and now a user can click on a check box and the system will remember your device for 30 days allowing you just login.
- An ongoing problem with my website, is that hackers keep trying to get into my Members Only Area.
- I am determined to stop them, therefore I have upped my security and now require 2 Factor Login's.
- I am very sorry if this causes a problem for you. It is necessary to keep all information safe, especially the Members Only Area.

More Discussion

- I am going to try to create a presentation that covers both the current users and any new users that choose to join my Members Only Area.
- I hope to make this clear enough to even help those who forget their passwords and how to fix that problem.
- Please feel free to comment on any part of this document as it is necessary so I can keep this as useful as possible.


Before you Login or Register




Before I try to login to the MOA of Ratsupport.com I start up my Authentication App and in this case I use the Authy App because it works on all my devices.

When you start it up it looks like this, and as you can see I have more than one login in the app.

I click on the Ratsupport Members Only listing and the app starts to display the Tokens (numbers). They last for 30 sec each and then a new one is generated.



What my Screen looks like




I position my browser and Authy windows side by side and this enables me to see the login to the MOA and the Tokens.

When I complete the initial login properly then the Token Screen will show and I can enter the token into the field and click the Return (Enter) key on my keyboard.




- The next few slides will discuss the Login Process for Ratsupport.com Members Only Area.
- By the way, it is **FREE** !!
- Important !You will need to do some things before you try to login to the Members Only Area. You will have to install one app to your phone, tablet or computer for Authentication. I have tried with success Google's(phone, tablet), Authy's(multiple devices, Linux), Microsoft's(phone, tablet) and even SafeToken app (works on my Kindle Fire HD).
- There are many that will work.
- These apps create a Token(number) every so often and the Tokens keep changing over time. This will insure no person can get this login info.



Notice that I have used Mozilla Firefox as my browser and have entered the URL of https://www.ratsupport.com.

To enter the Members Only Area one must select that area. One way, is to use the link on the home page of Ratsupport.com.

There is also a link at the bottom of the page and you could select the link that states Join the Members Only Area.



If this the first time to login since I put 2FA on the system, you have to install an Authentication app on either your phone, tablet or computer. You will need to set it up first so you can use it. (Google search to find instructions)

You should login to Members Only Area normally by putting your email address and password into the appropriate fields.

I will discuss how to recover your password, if you have lost it later. Please remember I require a new password every year.

After you put the proper username and password into the login fields and hit the Login Button you should see this on your screen.

This QR Code is used to associate ratsupport.com MOA to your phone, tablet or computer, depending on which Authentication app you choose, this is done only the first time when logging in.

Using the app you should scan the QR Code (the square image) with your phone or tablet.

If you put the Authy app on your computer, then copy and paste (might need to use ctrl-v to paste) the characters that are just below the QR code into your app.

The app will create a 6 digit number(Token) that gets entered into the Token field.

If you need help you can click on the ?.

Then hit the Login Button.





The ? Is for HELP !! it will take you to the Ratsupport.com's Help Page.

This is the normal 2FA screen for Token entry (number generated) by your app.

Just look at your app(on phone, tablet or computer) and get the Token (number) and enter it here, then hit the Login Button and you should get logged in to the Ratsupport Members Only Area.

If you want to avoid this box for 30 days then you can click on this check box and the system will remember (Trust) your device for 30 days and then you will have to enter a token and repeat the process.


If you are having problems you can click on the ? For help.

On my Linux machine I have Authy installed and it gives me the Token in the app on my computer screen.

If you currently don't have login permission (registered) to the Members Only Area then, you will need to register and be approved. Please click on the Not signed up yet? Please Register Link.

This will give a page where you can fill in some basic information about you.

If you don't fill in the information you will not be approved.

You need to get an email telling you that you are approved before you can login for the first time



We strongly suggest that you change your password on your Edit Profile page of the Members Only Area. There are requirements for password, so please read the instructions on the page.

Forgot My Password



If you don't remember your password then you can click on the Forgotten? Link and a new password will be sent to your registered email address(be sure to check spam/junk folder if you don't get answer in 5min.

Please look at the next slide for instructions on how to deal with this new password.

If you try to login 4 times and fail then you will be blocked for 10 min before you can try again. Look at bottom of the page where messages show up in Red.

Please use the following rules:

- 1. You can not use your old password so be sure to check for a message stating "That password has been already used"
- 2. You must have at least one number in your password.
- 3. You must have at least one Capital letter in your password.
- 4. You must have at least one Lower Case letter in your password.
- 5. You can use any or all of the following special char's. * % ; @ _ . < > ?
- 6. Your password must be atleast 5 chrs and not more than 30 chrs.

If you hit the Forgotten? Link. you will be sent an Email to your registered email address.

This Email will look something like this.

Please see the new password.

If you want to use this new password, you must activate it first by clicking on the Activate Now link.

You can then login with new password normally

- It is important for you to have the email address support@ratsupport.com in your address book.
 Members only area uses this email address to send you emails. It is common for comcast to put email into their spam folder so you might have to login to comcast and look there.
- If you expect an answer or communication from MOA of Ratsupport.com and don't see it, Please look in your Spam (Junk) folder for it.

- The Members Only Area has different tabs and information than the unprotected Ratsupport.com pages.
- Members Tab: is where information for and about the user is kept. If you have extra resources then a link will be put there in the block "Member Assets".
- Messages Tab: is where the user can communicate to Ratsupport.com or other Members via a message application.

- Chat Tab: is a standard chat application not unlike Facebook and others.
- Share the Experience Tab: is where information shared by members who send info to us for others to see.
- Member Files Tab: this is where a member or Ratsupport tech can place a file without having to send an email and the member has access to this file. Normally used to transfer files or presentations that are large to a member.

- Education Tab: this tab has links to many more presentations and information.
- Specials Tab: Members get special pricing and information.

- Edit Profile Tab: is where a member can change their password, change their information and link an image of them.
- The reasons I use Mozilla's Firefox Browser and Thunderbird is that I do most of my development on my Ubuntu Linux machine and Firefox tracks and shares across most of my devices so I don't have to make new links or contacts on each device.
