The Router will provide you with a hardware firewall that will limit outside persons from getting into your network. Also you can purchase a Router with wireless abilities and this will allow you to move about your house and stay connected to the internet. Some are just a simple home device and some are for small business that can include VPN (Virtual Private Network) and other features. If you are going to purchase a Wireless Router I suggest you get one that is Wireless N capable, this is the longest range and fasted as they are currently configured.
